14	<p>What would you like to change about Monteagle School?</p> <p>Children should be set tasks to do at home or at the weekends. It should be optional for parents who feel it's a burden to them but parents who are free and want their child to learn more should not be left out. A child's learning should not be stopped when at home and it's not always the case a child is having fun at home they may be more poorly behaved because they have nothing to do. How can a parent teach a child when they don't know what they have learnt at school? It's only when the child brings homework to their parents that they can teach accordingly. For example if they are learning about 2D shapes then at home parents can advance them to move on to 3D shapes. Also parents can see the methods of teaching so they can follow through rather than not having any work and teaching a different way that can confuse a child. The new website is a good start but unfortunately for those parents who has not got access to internet they miss out so it should cater to parents who don't have this facility.</p>

Regarding the homework, the management should improve about giving out the homework weekly.

I wish the school could give weekly homework and help children who have English as a second language.
